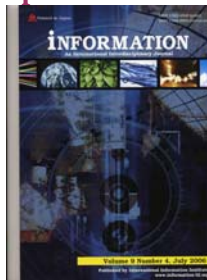

The selected papers, which have appeared in ACSA-10 (Seoul, Korea, December, 2010) symposium proceedings, could be submitted to this special issue.

Manuscripts must include: (1) the title, author's name(s), affiliation, abstract, and a list of keywords in English, and the title, author's name(s), affiliation, (2) the body of the manuscripts, (3) references, and (4) a brief curriculum vitae for each author.
