Submissions must not exceed 6~8 pages, including tables and figures, with only PDF. Submission of a paper implies that should the paper be accepted, at least one of the authors will register and present the paper in the conference.

All accepted papers will be included in the conference proceeding published by IEEE CS (Our proceedings will be included in EI and other index). The proceedings will be available at the conference. At least one author of an accepted paper must register at the conference
